

According to the Biblical teaching about sin, therefore, those who violate the law of God in any way whether they understand what the law of God requires or not are guilty of sin. Yet, according to the doctrine of the Sabbath as a test of loyalty to God in the last days, those who violate the fourth commandment by observing the Sabbath on the first day of the week because they do not understand what the fourth commandment requires are not guilty of sin. It is easy to see, therefore, that the doctrine of the Sabbath as a test of loyalty to God in the last days is incompatible with the Biblical teaching about sin.

This concludes the doctrines of Seventh-day Adventism which I will consider, for while there are other doctrines of Seventh-day Adventism which I could profitably consider, those doctrines are not essential to this thesis. Therefore, I will not discuss them at this time.
