CATALOG DESCRIPTION

A brief history of the movement will be considered, together with an examination of its doctrines in light of the Word of God, exegetically considered. Three hours.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

1. To familiarize the student with the history of the charismatic movement.
2. To make the student aware of the key doctrines of the charismatic movement.
3. To enable the student to determine whether or not there is a biblical basis for the key doctrines of the charismatic movement.
4. To help the student to decide what his attitude should be toward the charismatic movement.

METHODS EMPLOYED TOWARD SECURING COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. Reading of significant theological literature related to the topics considered in the course.
2. Reading of relevant passages from the English Bible.
3. In-class lecture and discussion.
4. Assignment of a paper on a specific passage of scripture.

PROCEDURES USED IN TESTING ACHIEVEMENT OF COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. Written examinations on the lecture material.
2. Evaluation of the paper.
