When Mr. Knorr became president, the work of the Jehovah's Witnesses was being carried on in only 54 countries. By 1961 it was being carried on in 185 countries.

- 4. Frederick W. Franz
  - a. *Born - September 12, 1893*  
Became president (June 22, 1977) *of the Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of Pennsylvania (1945)*
  - b. Published a new doctrinal book: You Can Live Forever in Paradise on Earth (1982)
  - c. Published a new edition of the New World Translation of the Holy Scriptures (1981)
  - d. *He died in December, 1992. He was replaced by Governing Body member Milton Henschel.*
- 5. Recent developments in the Watchtower Society
  - a. A significant number left the Watchtower Society after 1975 because their prediction that the world would come to an end in the autumn of 1975 didn't come true.
