- (a) He was the head of the Gilead Watchtower Bible school for 12 years.
- (b) He was disfellowshipped because he challenged the Watchtower's belief that only 144,000 could go to heaven.

- c. The rank and file Witnesses complain about ^{the} disciplines of the Watchtower

- (1) They complain about their rules regarding divorce
- (2) They complain about the refusal of the Watchtower to allow their members to engage in independent study of the Bible.
- (3) They complain about the refusal of the Watchtower to allow anyone to challenge an elder whether it be on moral, scriptural, or administrative grounds.

Anyone who challenges an elder on any of these grounds is likely to be disfellowshipped. Compare the case of Ted and Genevieve Shanks.
