

4. Jesus Himself claims to be God
 - a. John 8:58,59
 - b. John 10:27-39
 - c. Rev. 1:17,18
 Note: The Jehovah's Witnesses counter by citing:
 - (1) John 14:28
 - (2) I Cor. 11:3
 - (3) I Cor. 15:28

5. The Apostle Paul states that Jesus is God.
 - a. I Tim. 3:16
 - b. Titus 2:13
 - c. Col. 2:9
 - d. Phil. 2:5-8

6. The O.T. attests to the fact that Jesus is God.
(Isa. 9:6)

7. The N.T. identifies Jesus as the Jehovah (God) of the O.T.
 - a. John 19:31-37 cf. Zech. 12:10
 - b. John 12:41 cf. Isa. 6:1,5

8. The N.T. affirms that Jesus is God by presenting Him as a proper object of worship.
 - a. Worship in the sense of religious veneration is reserved only for God (Matt. 4:10)
 - b. Worship in the sense of religious venertion is not to be given:
 - (1) To a man (Acts 10:25,26)
 - (2) To an angel (Rev. 19:10 & 22:8,9)
 - (3) To the antichrist (Rev. 14:9-11)
 - (4) To the Devil (Matt. 4:8-10)
 - c. Worship in the sense of religious veneration is given to Jesus Christ (John 9:35,38; Matt. 14:33; and John 20:28)
