

white throne judgment death will be done away once and for all.

Then Paul adds, Do you want proof that death will one day be done away? Here is the proof. The proof is found in a prediction given in Psalm 8:6. The proof is that God hath put all things under His, that is Jesus', feet. In Psalm 8:6 God predicted that all things would be brought into subjection to Jesus. "But," (verse 27) "when He saith all things are put under him," That is, God said in Psalm 8:6 that all things were going to be put under Jesus--brought into subjection to Him, "it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him." God the Father is not saying, I Myself am going to be in subjection to Jesus. No, He is going to take everything else and is going to bring it into subjection to Jesus Christ. So, verse 28: "When all things shall be subdued unto him," when God the Father takes everything through Jesus and brings them into subjection to Him, "When all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself," in addition to all other things, "be subject unto him," that is, God the Father, "that did put all things under him," Jesus. God the Father put all things that were opposed to Jesus under Him, "that God (the Father) may be all in all."

This is going to happen, this turning over of the kingdom to God the Father to reign, after the great white throne judgment. God the Father will then receive the kingdom and the Son Himself will then be subject unto the Father. But this does not prove that Jesus is not God.

Let me give you an illustration. Here is a father and a son. The father has a human nature. The son has a human nature as well. But that father is not only the father of that son, he is a king as well. Now as king, his son, though he has the same nature as his father, is subject unto his father. Does that make a
