

1. Consonantal Sufformatives

- (i) Write the base form (e.g. אֵל).
- (ii) Add the consonantal sufformative to the end of the base form (e.g. אֵלֶיךָ).

NOTE: An alternate way for adding consonantal sufformatives in this stem is as follows:

- (i) Write the base form (e.g. אֵל).
- (ii) Add the consonantal sufformative to the end of the base form by means of a helping vowel which is a long seghol (e.g. אֵלֵיךָ).
- (iii) Drop the vowel under the personal preformative to a vocal shewa (e.g. אֵלֶיךָ - written without the vowel letter waw).

ii. Vocalic Sufformatives

- (i) Write the base form (e.g. אֵל).
- (ii) Add the vocalic sufformative to the end of the base form (e.g. אֵלַי).

(b) Personal Preformatives

The personal preformatives are added to the front of the base form by means of a qames (e.g. אֵלַי, אֵלֶיךָ, or אֵלֵיךָ), and אֵלַיְךָ).

(3) Imperative

(a) No Sufformative

The form is אֵל.

(b) Consonantal Sufformative

- i. Write the base form (e.g. אֵל).
- ii. Add the consonantal sufformative to the end of the base form (e.g. אֵלֶיךָ).

(c) Vocalic Sufformatives

- i. Write the base form (e.g. אֵל).
- ii. Add the vocalic sufformative to the end of the base form (e.g. אֵלַי).
