

Job 42:1-6 Job answers and now repents.

- v.2 - Sees God is Almighty, omniscient.
- v.3 - Recalls God's rebuke from 38:2.
 - Admits he has no understanding of God in the moral realm.
- v.4 - Admits his incompetence.
- v.5 - Confession: Had only heard of God before, now that he sees Him and His greatness,
- v.6 - He repents from
 - his lack of reverence during his sufferings, and
 - his pride in challenging God to a debate.

- But Job never had to repent from any sin which was the cause of his sufferings.
