

7. The Elder stands, prays, and sits down.
8. The Instrumentalist starts to softly play appropriate hymns.
9. The Elders all stand together, and take their positions in front of the Communion Table, facing the Pastor.
10. The Pastor distributes the bread plates to the Elders, and sits down.

The Pastor distributes the bread plates to the Elders to his right first, going from the outside to the inside; and then to the Elders to his left, going from the outside to the inside.

11. The Elder to the Pastor's far right steps forward and serves the Pastor the Bread.
12. The Pastor takes the Bread and lays it on the Communion Table in front of him.
13. The Elder returns to his position.
14. The Elders leave the Communion Table together and serve the Bread to the congregation.

As the Elders leave the Communion Table, the Pastor may announce to the congregation that they should hold the Bread and the Cup, and all partake together. However, this announcement shouldn't be made unless the Pastor feels it is absolutely necessary because it detracts from the service.

15. When the Elders have finished serving the Bread to the congregation, they take their positions at the back of the church, march to the front, and take their positions in front of the Communion Table, facing the Pastor. The Pastor stands as the Elders approach.
16. The Pastor collects the bread plates from the Elders, and the Elders take their seats.

The Pastor collects the bread plates from the Elders to his right first, going from the outside to the inside; and then from the Elders to his left, going from the outside to the inside.

17. The Pastor serves the Bread to the Elders.

The Pastor serves the Bread to the Elders to his right first, going from the outside to the inside; and then to the Elders to his left, going from the outside to the inside.

18. When the Pastor has finished serving the Bread to the Elders, the Instrumentalist stops playing.
