

19. The Pastor takes his place behind the Communion Table and while holding in his hand the Bread which had previously been served him, says the following words:

"Jesus said, 'Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.'" (1 Cor. 11:24)

20. The Pastor and the people partake of the Bread together.

21. The Pastor pauses for a moment of silent prayer.

22. The Pastor reads the following words:

"After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Lord's death till he come." (1 Cor. 11:25,26)

23. The Pastor calls on one of the Elders to his left to thank the Lord for the Juice which represents the blood of Jesus Christ which was shed for us.

24. The Elder stands, prays, and sits down.

25. The Instrumentalist starts to softly play appropriate hymns.

26. The Elders all stand together, and take their positions in front of the Communion Table, facing the Pastor.

27. The Pastor distributes the juice trays to the Elders, and sits down.

The Pastor distributes the juice trays to the Elders to his left first, going from the outside to the inside; and then to the Elders to his right, going from the outside to the inside.

28. The Elder to the Pastor's far left steps forward and serves the Pastor the Juice.

29. The Pastor takes the Juice and sets it on the Communion Table in front of him.

30. The Elder returns to his position.

31. The Elders leave the Communion Table together and serve the Juice to the congregation.

32. When the Elders have finished serving the Juice to the congregation, they take their positions at the back of the church, march to the front, and take their positions in front of the Communion Table, facing the Pastor. The Pastor stands as the Elders approach.
