(8) His emaciated body was made visible so that he could count all his bones vs. 17

(9) His enemies looked on him with fiendish delight vs. 17

Matt. 27:36-soldiers sat and watched

Luke 23:35-people stood beholding

(10) His enemies divided his clothes among them and gambled over one piece to determine who would get it-vs. 18

John 19:23, 24 and Mark 15:24

f. A mood of confidence-vss. 19-21 except the words “you have answered me”

Ground of confidence: God was source of his help
