Now, If I can contribute something toward making it a better book, or toward extending its usefulness for another copyright term, and making it a better book in the process, I'm glad I can contribute what I can toward that purpose. And the result was that I went into it expecting that there would be a considerable disagreement/^{on many points}between me and many of the others in the group. And I was going to give whatever particular help I could on particular things and whatever specialized knowledge I had would be made available. The result was, I wasn't excited trying to get my ideas into it, trying to get it to be just what I'd like it to be. I was interested in being what help I could. So I wasn't tense like some of the others were. One of them said to me, You had more influence than anybody else had in the changes that were made!
