- 1 Isaac's unoriginal character
- 2 Isaac's faith in God based upon Abraham's example  
s Responsibility of leaders on minor points
- 3 Followers may carry small errors to become a major harm  
Bride for Isaac took searching. Rebecca's character
- 4 Laban's avarice  
Isaac--the dutiful son and follower, not a leader.  
Better to be a follower of one who is true than a leader of what is false
- 5 Isaac's fleshly preference  
Abraham wanted God's will to prevail thru him  
Isaac content that God's will prevail in spite of him
- 6 What Abraham did knowing it was the Lord's will; Isaac had to be put up to  
doing by his wife.  
Loss of spiritual discernment in Isaac as cf. with Abraham  
Isaac's life ends in sadness and unsatisfaction with him vainly striving  
to do what is contrary to God's plan
- 7 "older serve younger" and Dr. Allis' interpretation  
Power of the blessing
- 8 Story of Mark Twain writing down his experiences.  
Foreordination/ free will
- 9 Rebecca's sin offset. Isaac's sin causing the result to be what God intended
- 10 Unnecessary for Rebecca to sin in order to prevent Isaac from sinning
