Now it's going all right. That's fine. Thank you, Mr. . It's good to have an electrical expert in here. I never would have dreamed of doing that. Now we spent most of our last time in dealing with the evidence in the New Testament on the rapture and we only got decently started on that subject. We have much more to do with it and we also have much more to do with the Isaiah apocalypse. Mr. Horner suggested after class that we could very well spend two hours every week instead of every other week to really reach final conclusions on the matter before us and I think that means perhaps we need to go a little bit faster than we did last time. I really think we can get over the main basic things with our one hour a week course all right but perhaps we should go a little faster. I'm very sorry Mr. Horner has a sore throat and is in bed today and won't be able to be with us today but we hope that he will be with us next time. And that brings us to mention the matter of next time. It has been my intention to, as I told most of you I think when we began, to meet these three times during February and then to meet in April and May and not to meet in March at all.
