of God, and Dr. Buswell, speaking about it later, said, "He saved the minute between minutes," and I thought it was very aptly put for the way Martin Walsh never loses an opportunity to present the Word of God to someone. Dr. Machen used to complain. He said, "In Seminary we have students who come in here. They take every examination and get a top grade in it, they do excellent work. You give them a paper to write and they turn it in and it is just splendid, and they graduate and they go out and you never hear from them, and what happens? They work under pressure. They work under command and they get out in a church, they settle down and they have to get a sermon ready and they rush their heads off Saturday night preparing the sermon for Sunday morning and maybe Sunday afternoon preparing one for Sunday night, and they rush Wednesday afternoon getting something ready for prayer meeting and then the rest of the week they're thinking about what they are going to start to get ready to do as soon as they get time for it and the time just flitters away and goes and that, of course, is one of the great troubles with our American educational system, that we give you something to do and you do it and we give you a mark and you don't learn to do things by your own initiative and say, "I've got to get this done. Now, this is necessary," and now in the last two lectures in Old Testament and in Church History I haven't given you any assignments. I've given you lots of time. I trust that means you've all reviewed last semester's work and that you will be all ready for the examination. The hours that I haven't assigned would put every one of you in a position to know that thoroughly, but if you are at all like most students are, if you are like myself, let us say, I think it likely
