

Out of 29 Subaran names, 5 are Hurrian, 5 Semitic, a couple Elamite.

Sub-<sup>lu</sup> prob Sulliam

Subartu one equates with AŠŠUR

In one Assy. text the phrase occurs *nim Subartu*

Term used somewhat differently in South (Bab.) or in north (Assy.)

Used <sup>in Bab.</sup> with Elam,

Guti, Sulu

A Nippur miser. reports Nippur, Subartu, Hamazi, 4th last-named is, in the Sulu country

Hamazi one speaks of fighting with ~~Sulu~~ Gut and Subartu, who he describes as in distant language, mountainous and with ~~of~~ <sup>several</sup> languages

It is not a term for limitless territory, far to the north. Use of nearer land and people
