Here we have in general then his humiliation but it is more or less in general and it gets to be more specific in verse 3. "He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not."

Now that does not seem to fit the usual impression we have of the ministry of Jesus when we read of the throngs coming to him and of the disciples saying if we leave you ~~XXXXXXXX~~ who will we go to. You have an impression in the gospels of the great deal of attractiveness his message, his personality and so on.
