but I don do think that the Christian World has suffered from our ignorance of this, because we talk we too much about evolution and Darwinism, etc. with very know little knowledge of what it really is, what really happened. And Darwin gets a lot of credit for things he shouldn't get credit for and perhaps he doesn't get blamed for things he should and so I wanted to try to touch a few of-them-that of the factors in here. Well, now the first thing is a very common misconception that evolution started with Daw Darwin. This is completely false. This book of Newman's here has an historical sketch in which he shows some of ancient the Greeks who taught evolution, he shows different ones through the ages who taught what he thinks could be properly called evolution, but he certainly shows some of whom there sou no question could be -- there was Lamarc 50 years or so before Darwin. Lamarc in France, who taught a theory that everything--all species developed from one simple source and of course Lamarc worked out high/the high folage the details and that an a giraffe wanted to reach a tree / and so his neck stretched and streched so hard ...people laughted at Lamarc and he was widely criticized and he didn't get much of a hearing, but in most of his details he is very close to-quite-a-few to what evolutionists teach today, and Darwin's own grand-father, Erasmus Darwin, wrote a long poem, which was not widely paid attention to, but quite a few people were aware of it, and in this poem , Erasmus Darwin presented a thorough-going theory of Evolution, and it is something that it- is certainly not a new idea when Darwin wrote his book. Darwin's book came out in 1846-1859; 12 years earlier, in 1847, this Disraeli, who was later British Prime Minister, published a novel_____, and in this book he wred- wrged-a a fashionable lady urged a hero to read a current best-seller and she said, "You know, all thesedevelopements-, developing, the principle is perpetually going on. First, there was nothing, then there was something, ...and the next change there will be
