We can gather many things with absolute certainty from the Bible. Then having gathered ~~these~~, we can go on, and ~~we can~~ gather ~~gather-~~ still more things, and we can constantly increase in our ability to interpret it, and therefore in our certainty as to ~~the~~ ^{the} understanding, but it rests upon the ^{solid} foundation, because it is the word of the Almighty God, And of Him who alone is truth, and is free from error. We follow truth wherever it leads, in a sense that we following - the Lord Jesus Christ as He leads us into the treasures of His word. But we should be sure ^{really} that He is ~~leading~~, and that we are not led astray by our own prejudices, ~~by~~ our own preconceived ideas, our own wishes or desires. Now thus God is the source of truth. However, man is also a source of truth. God has given us the revelation of many things in the Bible.
