

after I finished one of the leaders came up to me and he said My, you certainly were communicating <sup>this morning</sup> & Now, I never had that precise term used in that way at any time when I had spoken before, <sup>but</sup> that is the ~~reage~~ ~~toda~~ ~~rage~~ today, <sup>because</sup> and it is very sensible <sup>to</sup> communicate ~~on to com~~ - an idea from one mind to another is a very complex and difficult process even though it is one of the <sup>simplest</sup> ~~simpler~~ facts of life in that it is one of the common features, <sup>one of the common exper</sup> ~~We~~ communicate an idea, it is the simplest thing from our earliest childhood and ~~that~~ ~~het~~ - yet ..communication is very involved and complex, and revelation is a little broader than communication; communication conveys the idea that <sup>it</sup> is ~~int~~ ~~ted~~ intentional, that is-- it is voluntary and certainly God's revelation is intentional, <sup>it is voluntary on his part</sup> but our word revelation in common use & conveys the idea, not merely of intention, <sup>of communication</sup> but of any passing on of an idea which one might not have known otherwise, <sup>We reveal something</sup> ~~we~~ when we open ~~up~~ <sup>up</sup> or ~~unve~~ <sup>unve</sup> uncover something that was previously hidden, when we pass on an idea which others were not aware previously that we had, <sup>I</sup> I think that myself that it is a little unfortunate that we tend to use the word revelation simply ~~as~~ in the sense of divine revelation, ~~simply~~ simply in the sense of what God ~~reveals~~ <sup>reveals</sup> reveals, because the similarity is so close between what God reveals, <sup>to us</sup> and what we reveal to one another; that is, as far as the prophets are concerned the similarity is & so close, and the analogies are so many that I feel that our ~~understand~~ understanding is improved <sup>in any way</sup> rather than ~~confused~~ <sup>confused</sup> if we use revelation with the idea ~~the~~ <sup>of</sup> that the whole Bible ~~is~~ body of communication, not just divine communication, & I reveal myself, <sup>by merely</sup> not only by my words but ~~my~~ <sup>my</sup> by my tones, by my manner, you can look at a person which often believe <sup>you get certain ideas</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>which</sup> ~~which~~ <sup>which</sup> ~~sometimes~~ <sup>sometimes</sup> leads to a better understanding, which ~~sometimes~~ <sup>sometimes</sup> leads you to interpret their words in an entirely different way than you would
