Paul had a word about this in I ~~Cor~~ Corinthians 9. I Corinthians 9, verses 18 to 23. He says, ~~For though I am free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more.~~ ~~Verily that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my right in the gospel.~~ 'What is my reward then? ~~Verily that, when I preach the~~ Verily that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my right in the gospel. For though I am free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more. And unto the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might gain the Jews; to them that are under the law, as under the law, not being myself under the law, that I might gain them that are under the law; To ~~them~~ them that are without law, as without law (being not without law to God,) (this next phrase omitted: but under the law to Christ,) that I might gain them that are without law. To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak; I am ~~made~~ made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some." We must never do what is wrong, but in accomplishing God's purposes He gives us the truth and He wants us to figure out ways in which we can make it effective, ways in which we can reach people, and the way that ~~in which~~ one person uses effectively another person may not be able to use effectively. But we should spend our time and energy trying to find ways to get God's message across, not simply ~~throwing~~ throwing stones at other ~~people~~ people whose words we ^{may} think we can twist to give a meaning which they themselves often declare is not what they mean at all.
