About 70 or 80 years ago when modernism was beginning to sweep through Scotland those great theological institutions there that had produced so many wonderful theological books and from which so many great Christian leaders have gone out to all parts of the world, were beginning to have the answers ? of the higher criticism and the turning away of people's attention from there was a great scholar by the name of James Denny who was very highly thought of ? in the land, and who wrote a book called THE DEATH OF CHRIST in which he was conservative strength to observe conserve? the emphasis upon the death of Christ And to point out what so many Christians were forgetting and neglecting that the death of Christ is after all the very central theme of the NT. His book became quite a classic in this regard. A few later years after James Orr, the great apologist? who was standing for the faith, but I was shocked to find when I was in Scotland, in England in 1947, that James Orr was not recognized anything like as much as I think he deserved to be, but Denny was still regarded as a very great scholar and what he wrote ~~deserved~~ considered a great work, and I think the reason, I believe they were equally great scholars, but I think the difference was that when Denny wrote modernism was beginning to come in and this great book that showed the weakness in the foundation of modernism showed the importance of the death of Christ in the Christian religion and though James Orr was a generation later when modernism had nearly gained control of the universities in Scotland,
