e. We should show love to all men. ~~we~~ but should remember that Satan is actively ~~uszz~~ using individuals to hold people in bondage or to hinder believers growth in grace. These we should oppose with all our might. These we ^{One of the} most beautiful ^{wonderful} psalms is Ps. 139. Most Christians are familiar with that ~~beautiful~~ psalm. It ends up, "SEarch me O God and know my heart and try me and know my thoughts and see if there be any wicked way in me and lead me in the way everlasting." It is probably one of the 10 best known psalms, but how often we overlook that 21st verse; "Do not I hate them O Lord that hate thee. Am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee." We are to love those who are lost in sin, to have compassion over them and to pray that God will enable us to reach them for Himself, but those whom Satan is actively using to hold people in bondage, there is a true Christian hate ~~and~~ ^{and} there is a true Christian love, but never necessarily a continuing hate because there is always the possibility that God will reclaim them. Even toward them we must show a very true spirit of true Christian love trying to help them ^{to} and ^{to} reclaim but opposing their wicked works to the utmost and never joining with them in them.

1 John 4:1 the great Apstotke of love, John, said, "Beloved believe not every Spirit but try the spirits whether they are of God ~~or of the world~~ because many false prophets are gone out into the world." And in 2 John 7-11, he spoke more strongly on this ~~to~~. He said "For many deceivers are entered in the world who confess not that J. C. is come in the flesh --- the incarnation, the very center of Christian belief and Christian teaching. Those who deny the deity of Christ, deny that God is actually come in the flesh, He says that this is a deceiver and an antichrist. "Look to yourselves that we loose not those things which we have wrought but that we receive a full reward. Whosoever transgresseth and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ hath not God.
