But miracles in the ordinary sense of the world we find mostly confined to four

definite groups - We have the coming out of Egypt and the quanturing of the

promised land. We have this great event which God supernaturally entered into

at many definite points, -- the plagues of Egypt, the events of the Red Sea, and

through the wilderness there are many points at which He did and many points at

which he did not.

And then we go along in the history of the Israelites and we find very little that is not --- people to whom God spoke, yes; people with whom God had definite happening relationship but in the events of their lives everything happens in relation/to And there the Baal worship natural situations until you get to Elinah and Elisha. was coming into the land and leading the people astray and threatening to wipe out entirely the memory of the true God, God poured out a/number of wonderful miracles in the lives of those two great saints - Elijah and Elisha. That is a rather isolated situation. And then we have in connection with the exile -- only really in connection with the life of Daniel. Very very little in connection with Isa. Considerable in connection with Daniel. But the period of the exile when again it were simply seemed as if the knowledge of God might be wiped out if the by people/assimilated who worshipped to those around them fulthe / working of idols; and then of course the Coming of Christ and the early spread of Christianity when it was just like a little candle light - a small flame that the Lord protect with/supernatural activity until it should spreadout to many areas. And since that time in many an area the light of Christianity has burned briefatly brilliantly and then anti-Christian forces have come along and completely wiped it out. And there are areas of the world which at but one time were great Christian areas with thousands of believers where the people turned aside from God and the very name of Christ has been completely forgotten.
