 I believe as you read the names of these men, you think of the thousands of Israel
 there, and you think of these 12 men who are the leaders of them. And you read the
 names of the men and his father, and most of them you have never heard of before and
 you will never hear of again. But all this detail is here given about the offering which
 they gave. And you read that you can't help but thinking, How small is human fame. How
 unlasting is human fame. There is this man who gave this charger of gold and these
 talents of silver, and the ram and the lamb and all this, and he was the headover all
