the Chn° worker must stand with the good and oppose the evil, but cannot expect a commplete victory over it until God Himself does away with the evil in the world after it has served its purpose in accordance with His wonderful purpose. The third parable speaks of a grain of mustard seed which grows slowly and not easily observed, and yet eventually becomes a tremendous thing. This kan shows that though the REMER Gospel is a living, vital force, which moves forward often without sometimes its progress cannot be clearly observed, but the results of it may be very tremendous.

To go further and d say that the fact that it is that the birds of the air lodge in its branches shows the coming of evil to utilize the good things that God establishes brings in a truth which is clearly observable, but it is kigky highly questionable whether it is any part of the teaching of this parable.

The fourth parable speaks of the slow spreading of leaven until everything is affected by it.

It would seem that the basic thought of this is that there is to are to be widespread effects, not perhaps so visible as those symbolized by the growth of the tree, but very far reaching and pervasive.

and this of course has a parallel to the fact that the Chn° church is a result
