I heard the statement made, Be not the first to take on something new, be not the last to give up the old. Now of course if the old is true we should cling to it. If the new is bad we should not accept it. But this refers to secondary matters, unimportant matters and in these how easy it is to put big stress on little unimportant matters. Let us fit in with the view of people where we work on these matters.
