

These organizations began as a reaction against over-emphasis of denominationalism and there were in the original leaders of them individuals who were truly anxious to get greater efficiency in the Lord's work, by having people who agreed on the great fundamentals work together, more effectively. But soon they were overbalanced and ~~comp~~ placed in a complete minority by the coming in of a new leadership whose whole interest was in social change, whose whole interest was in completely changing the situation. If they have their way, and if the Lord tarries we will all be reduced within a half a century to a situation of living that most of us had 1000 years, barely able to struggle to get enough to eat and with practically no means of ~~ax~~ transportation, because all of the great advantages we enjoy today would eventually disappear, as a result of that sort of activity.

Of course we, as Christians, are far more interested than in that aspect of it in the way that these leaders deny the great teachings of the word of God and attack and destroy faith in it. So I would like to urge that all of you keep up with the developments of the NCC and WCC, and be able when you talk with people who have a natural ~~grat~~ great loyalty to the organizations ~~of which they are~~ in which their parents and grand parents lived, to point out to them the activities of these organizations in which the leaders of their denominations are exerting so important an influence.
