2^a A further question asked in the Assignment has to do with Matt. 26:64:
Mark 14:62, Luke 22:69

Mt 26 "And Jesus saith unto him " hereafter ye shall see the Son of man "sitting on the right hand of power and coming in the clouds of heaven

Ans. As we mentioned above, in this verse we see the term in Daniel 7:13 "Son of Man" used by Christ when referring to himself in regard to his second coming.

Mk 14:62 and Jesus said I am: and ye shall see "the Son of man" sitting at the right hand of power and coming in the clouds of heaven
Lk 22:69 Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.

In the verses quoted above- over 600 years later than Daniel- we see who this title "Son of Man" fitted because Jesus himself owned it, when as the self-attesting Christ he identified himself to the Jews and their leaders in his day when he walked the earth in the first century A.D.

So the title "Son of Man" in Daniel must be taken literally we can see in later records. in the New Testament at the time Daniel prophesies about.

To the question in the assignment Do these verses prove anything about Jewish interpretation of Daniel 7:13 at the time of Christ

Ans. Yes they were well known to the religion leaders for they convicted Christ of blasphemy for using this title of "Son of Man" from Daniel as his own and identifying himself as the one would be "sitting at the right hand of power and coming in the clouds of heaven." For they knew this individual was equal with deity in the book of Daniel that is the messiah - the coming one/ therefore by Christ's using this statement they proved he was a blasphemer masquerading as a member of the Godhead.

List each usage of the term Ancient of Days in Daniel 7. What can you tell about its precise meaning in each case.

Ans: The title "Ancient of Days" is used three times in Chap. 7

Dan. 7:9 The use of the phrase "Ancient of Days" in this verse is in relation to the end of secular history when the thrones of the four main Kingdoms or Empires are cast down then shall the "Ancient of Days" take over the reins- that is the time when the Kingdom of God will triumph over the kingdoms of the world.

Dan. 7:13 Time of events in this verse are pretty well parallel with the description in Rev: 19 of the return of Christ with the resurrected saints.

Daniel 7:22 depicts the time when the "little Horn" is persecuting the Jewish saints in the tribulation and tells us clearly that this will be interrupted by the "Ancient of Days" According to our interpretation of this title then we reckon with a new element or another member of the Godhead to appear in that moment when the evil world Dictator and his cohorts are confronted with Deity as outlined elsewhere and in the 2 verses before v 22, which give us the context
