Assignment in Prophecies of Daniel

This assignment involves looking through Daniel 11, copying certain words and making a notation after each. You may use any version you wish. Please state at the top of the page what version you use. The words to be copied are those that designate any ruler, whether they be nouns or pronouns. They are to be placed in a column, one below the other. After each entry write the number of the verse, followed by the letters, a, b, c, d, etc., starting with the beginning of each new verse. If a ruler indicated by a noun is in your opinion identical with one who has already been mentioned, place after the name an equals sign (=), and then a reference to the place where he was named previously. In the case of every pronoun referring to a ruler write an equals sign, followed by a reference to the place where he was first indicated. In case of doubt two references may be put with the word "or" between them, or one reference with a question mark. As an example let us suppose that three verses read as follows:

1. The king of the north shall fight against the king of the south and he shall win a great victory. 2. The king of the south shall return to his own land disconsolate and troubled. He shall send him great tribute. 3. The king of the south shall try to win back what his father had lost, but he shall not succeed.

Such a passage would be handled as follows:
