and feel you've got to quit for some reason or other, come and see me day or night, morning or afternoon anytime and I'll be only too glad to see you and try to help you, because I desire to do what I can to make each of you make your life count to the utmost for Christ.

If you have some problem you'd like to talk to me about but you can do it today or you can do it tomorrow, or you can do it the next day, it is not an emergency, please do not bother me then. Please go to the office and ask them to make an appointment for you, and Mrs. Taylor will call me and find out a time that is convenient, because I'm working very hard trying to prepare some books for publication, and particularly in the mornings I'm trying to devote my mind which is worth double in the morning what it is in the afternoon for this writing. So please try to make with me an appointment that will be mutually convenient, and I'll make it just as soon as you feel it is necessary. If necessary I'll make itZZZZZZZ immediately, but if you can make it the next day or the day after or maybe even the next week and preferably in the afternoon, though if the afternoon is too inconvenient for you I'll do it in the a.m., but make an appintment and I'll meet you and I'll MXXX whatever time I possibly can to try to help you. But whatever I can try to do to help you, it is up to you to show the musar, to show think through what I say, and to accept it or reject it but do it intelligently and then to work and try to develop those aspects of your personality, of your particular ability that God will use. I want to do everything I can and I'm sure every member of the faculty wants to do everything we can to help you in those regards.
