sin, and they were certainly/saved as ~~well~~ as anybody here today

He says, And thou Capernaum who are exalted unto heaven shall be

brought down to hades. Well, you go to Capernaum today and you find

a few ruins. Is that the fulfillment of that? He continues: For

if the mighty works which have been done in thee had been done in

Sodom it would have remained unto this day, but I say unto you, it

shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of

judgment than for you Capernaum with the many godly people in it

and of course some who were ungodly. Sodom where they could not

find more than one family that was worthy to be delivered from

destruction, and in that you read in Gen. about

Lor's daughters and you wonder if anyone was found who was godly in

that city. But he says it will be more tolerable for the land of

Sodom in the day of judgment than for you. Mystery in God's will!
