

You can easily gather that information from the next few verses. How did he become king? (2) What relation did he have to the king of the south? What does it tell about his relation to the king of the south? (3) What do these verses (21-35) tell about God's people and about this king's relation to them? Gather that ~~the~~ information from vv. 21-35. What particular statements fall under each of these heads? We will discuss that next time. We will be discussing these verses which relate to the history of the Seleucus and the Ptolemies and I have mimeographed a general statement of the history that I would like you each to take a copy of.
