We cannot give == get too much understanding of the Bible. God will use everything we get. God wants us to learn to know His word. I belive that a man who is willing to try hard can accomplish much in the pastorate, some in one phase, some in another phase of it. There are special gifts some of us have, you might do better work in N.J. than you would in Brasil. You might do better work in Afraica than in the state of Washington. We vary.

But in most cases I don't think it matters half so much where you work as what kind of work youare doing where you are. The most important thing is that we put God first and learn to seek His will above all things. Let us pray:

Our father, we thank you that you in your word have given us the truth we need. We thank you that fou have given us the opportunity of studying it and digging into it, of making it a part of our minds, a partof our hearts, a part of our lives. If there are any who have questions and uncertainties as to where you want them to serve, what you want them to do, help us to keep our eyes on you, on Christ and to know that He will lead in one way or another if we put Him first and study His Word to find it. We ask in Jesus' Name. Amen
