- 1. Judges 5:24 Deborah's act of treachery is greeting with a triumphant benediction higher than that bestowed upon the Virgin Mary herself.
- 2. Ex.34:7(visiting the iniquity of the fathers ppon the children...) with Ezek. 18:14,17(son...shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall sumely live) with Jer. 32:18,19(recompense the iniquity of the fathers upon their children . . .)
- 3. Death of Judas Iscariot (Mat.27:5 with Acts 1:18)
- 4. Death of Saul (2 Sam.21:12 with 1 Sam.31:4 and 2 Sam.1:10)
- 5. Ex.12:40(430 yrs.) with Gen. 15:13(400 yrs.) with Acts 7:6(400 yrs.)
- 6. Gen.46:27 (70 souls) with Acts 7:14(75 souls)
- 7. Hebrews 9:4 altar of incense vs. censer
- 8. Acts 9:7 with 22:9 ("Voice" can mean "sound")

- 10. How could the Egyptians have had any cattle left to be killed by hail(Ex.9:19, the 7th plague), when Ex.9:6 says that all of them had been killed by murrain(the 5th plague).

- 12. 2 Chron. 9:25 states that Solomon had 4,000 stalls for horses and chariots, whereas 1 Kings. 4:26 states he had 40,000 stalls.
