chapter six

- 14 v.4 posts of the door - foundations of the thresholds(NASB)
- v.5 dwell in the midst - live among
- v.7 sin is purged - sin is covered
- v.10 make heavy - make their ears deaf

chapter seven

- 16 v.1 went up to war against it but could not prevail against it - went to attack it but could not attack it "The last clause is more specific than 'they could not prevail against it'(RV), which might imply failure after a long seige; it means that they were not even able to make any active assault on the city"(G.B.Gray in ICC)
- v.2 Syria has encamped in Ephraim - Syria(Aram) is resting() upon Ephraim.
- v.4 Take heed and be quiet for these two stubs of smoking firebrands - because of the two tails of these smoking firebrands
- 16 v.5 have taken evil counsel - have conspired evil against you
- v.11 ask it either in the depth or in the height above - make the request deep or make it high above.
- 17 v.15 that he may know - until he knows when he knows
- desolate valleys - steep ravine
- holes of the rocks - clefts of the rocks
- thorns - thorn bushes
- v.25 a heath for sheep - a trampling place for for trampling of sheep
