v.5 omits 'changed the ordinance'(KJV)

violate a statute

v.6 those who live in it are desolate

those who live in it are held guilty (NASB)

its people must bear their guilt(NIV)

v.12 the gate is stricken with destruction

the gate is battered to ruins(NASB)  
the gate is battered to pieces(NIV)  
the gate is crushed(Young)

v.13 when it shall be thus

so it will be (NIV)  
this is what it will be like(Beck)

v.15 glorify God in the lights

therefore in the east give glory to God(NIV)  
therefore glorify God in the east(NIV)  
in the east glorify the Lord(Young)  
(See Young p.170 for discussion)

v.20 shall waver like a hut

it totters like a shack(NASB)  
it sways like a hut in the wind(NIV)  
it swingeth like a hammock(Delitzsch)  
(Young gives discussion on the meaning of  $\text{וַיִּשְׁׁוּׁוּ} \text{ p.177}$ )

v.7 the surface of the covering

the face of the covering (KJV)  
the covering that covers(Delitzsch, Young)

the shroud that covers or enfolds

v.11 with the trickery of their hands

with the skill of His hands  
despite the cleverness of their hands (NIV)

$\text{וַיִּשְׁׁוּׁוּ}$  only occurs here

LXX has  $\text{ἐπιβόλη}$  →

trickery of his hands(NASB),  
LXX: Those things on which he has laid his hands  
(Agree better with KJV)

straight wilt thou level the path of the just(Young)

v.12 in us
