

Then follows a large dark triangle of very high proximity and uniform and uninterrupted density. By tracing its composition as to subcategories in Col. 2 we immediately recognize that it derives exclusively from category N and that, as far as Documents are concerned, I and E alternate at random as if they never existed. Only one lonely NP-sample intrudes the conglomerate of NI and NE: no. S. When looked up in the list of Sample Limits, no. S is seen to be roughly identical with ch. S 14, the one chapter which commentators were at a loss to attribute to any Document and which they designated in consequence to be a foreign body — either very ancient or a very late accretion to Genesis. The analysis demonstrates that it is actually fully consonant with I = E. Incidentally, S 10. S 11 is also quite enlightening: not one of the S 26 samples in the present triangle comes from Division S 11 and S 111 was already brought to light by Discriminant Analysis.
