

unbelief. The so-called Neo-orthodoxy follows the teaching of Barth and Brunner, who themselves deny large portions of the Scripture, even regarding parts of it as myths and legends. Worst of all, many of its leaders take an attitude toward the entire Bible which makes it not a source of knowledge in which we can learn the facts that God wants us to know, but merely a useful help toward a mystical experience, with no interest in the question whether its statements are true or not.

What a wonderful treasure God has given His church in the Word of God, pure, perfect, undefiled, free from error. It is living and vital. Thank God for the evangelical Conference here with its emphasis upon the Word of God. May the leaders of Protestantism throughout South America be vigilant to the dangers of encroaching unbelief. May they ever take a strong stand against the unbelief of the so-called World Council of Christian Churches, and continue in the course their churches have followed from their inception, standing truly for the Word of God, and preaching salvation by faith alone, through the finished work of Jesus Christ, our Saviour. May they ever give absolute loyalty to the complete teaching of the inerrant Word of God.
