

EPILOGUE

In this book we have tried to examine the principal matters of future prophecy that are clearly taught in the Word of God. Many Bible scholars will feel that other matters might well be added. We could add some ourselves. We have tried, however, to restrict ourselves, as far as possible, to matters that are so clear in the Word of God that if anyone is willing to lay aside his preconceptions and prejudices, and simply see what the Bible says, he should have no doubt that these matters at least are clearly taught in it.

Various students will feel a similar degree of certainty about other matters. These we have not gone into in this book. Many students of the Bible will feel that they can add considerable detail at many points on the ground of statements that are somewhat less clear than those we have quoted, but which seem to them to settle the matters involved. Much additional can be learned by careful study of the Bible, but we are confident that nothing that can properly be thus determined can reverse anything that has been set forth in this book.

It is our feeling that it is more important to find what is clear and positive in the Word of God, and to stand strongly upon it, than to make decisions on matters on which people of equal sincerity and equal ability can arrive at different opinions. For this reason we have restricted our area of study. We send this book forth with the prayer that God will bless it to the use of many, and will lead many to find the blessing that God has in store for them through understanding the clear teachings of His Word on these vital points.
