

And so we have them settled in the land of Canaan, and then we have comparatively little of the miraculous ~~in~~^{through} the history of the Judges, and through the history of the early kings, comparatively little that we would call miraculous, though many marvellous acts of God are found and then you get that Baal ~~worship~~ worship sweeping down from the north and that Baal worship comes to the land which was far stronger force than the local idolatry, ^{in Canaan} and it would have swept the knowledge of God out of the land, and God poured out His miracles under Elijah and Elisha, because God was determined to preserve the witness, ^{there} and then you have, of course, the great step forward ~~to~~ - under Elijah and Elisha, and then ^{again you have} dropping down until God sent them to exile, and then in the exile where they might have scattered and disappeared, ^{among} the people would have been forgotten, God poured out His miracles in connection with Daniel there in order to preserve the witness to Himself ^{through} in the exile, and brought them back into the land, and then the same ~~thing~~ thing repeated in the New Testament. We have Jesus coming with His marvellous revelation of God and ~~the~~ Jesus coming with His salvation as He provided for all of us who would believe on Him, and then you have the little group, you have the little group of disciples, ^{all} ~~those~~ who know the Lord, who know the true message and God pours out His miracles as the gospel begins to spread. And then it is spread ~~throughout~~ ^{throughout} the land then if the people keep their eyes on Him, ^{and} follow Him and seek to do His will, He pours out His blessing and ^{if} the people let sin win, triumph in their lives and leaves them on, He turns His eyes away from them.
