But now, the second phase of it, was the selction of temporary leaders or preachers. The selction of temporary leaders and preachers, to determine the is to preach. In this particular point, again we have the hierarachical system, in which the preacher, the minister has the complete authority, who is going to text take his leave when he is away. Who is going to fill in.

Whitiexx Who is going to assist in all the functions. The minister has the completel authority, or the man above him in the hierarchical system. Then we have the congregational system where the congregation makes the selection entire entirely in this thing. Whenevershex Then we have the Presbyterian system, in which in this, if it is a function of thex preaching, he should be a man whom the presbytery has approved. At least of having him under care. Usually of having him at least liscensed.(end of record)

So you will find that in most churches if it is not a presbyterian system, it devolves on the minister. And it devolves to quite an extent on the minister. So it is function, in general, of the inner control of the church. And in its general features it goes along with others. We will look at it later.

Now, the third thing. (several questions)

Well, now, the third is the matter of mit the change of a pairwax pastor. The change of a pastor. To determine who shall preach to a congregation.

Now supposing that the minister who is in the church is/doing a particularly good job. The qualifications of the man prove unworthy. In other words, he is heretical, or he falls into sin. I am thinking of a case where he doesn't do a very good job. Now this ax is a point in ch. govt., which is important. What is going to happen to the church. I know of a church where the man was installed, a church in Philadelphia, the church would seat 600 people, and there were that many people the night he was installed. Every seat was taken and there were people standing up. And there were found people wouldn't
