

- (3) Class Organization
 - (a) Class rooms--blackboards, maps and charts, overhead projector, pictures, place for discussion
 - (b) Self-Government--develops responsibility and leadership. Permits creativity
 - (c) Social Contacts--this is mating period so where better to meet mate than in Christian environment. Lays foundation for Christian marriage and home.
 - (d) Class Activities--provides outlet for altruistic and patriotic ideals such as Thanksgiving and Christmas baskets or gifts, programs, parties, etc. Also other programs for Rest Homes, Missions, etc. Also develops talent for choir, readers, instrumentalists, drivers, decorators, etc.
- (4) Appropriate Curriculum
 - (a) More specific study of Word--Bible proofs, deeper insight, doctrine, poetical books, prophetic books, teacher training to provide substitutes, etc.
- (5) Vocational Appeal--time of life decisions
 - (a) Christian Stewardship--time, talents, money
 - (b) Christian Home
 - (c) Christian Heroes--Bible, Church History, Missions
 - (d) Christian Ministry--Preaching, Counselling, Teaching, Serving or Helping.

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
