--in the ~~101-~~119th Psalm we noticed yesterday that the words that God says
~~aeu-~~ about this written revelation. The whole 119th Psalm has as its principal
theme the great revelation that God has given to us. ~~Iw~~ will just call your
attention now again to two verses, verse 89. ~~Thy Wor-~~ Forever, O Lord,
thy Word is settled in heaven. And verse 160, Thy Word is true from the ~~begini-~~
beginning and everyone of thy righteous judgments endures forever. Then we
get over to the New Testament. We find that the N.T. ~~wri-~~ writers, what
we are bringing you is the ~~k~~ message of fulfillment of what is predicted in the
Old Testament. We are telling you that which the prophets have predicted.
We are giving you what ^God has promised. The Old ~~Festmane-~~ Testament and
the New Testament is God's Word and something that we can constantly follow.
The Apostle Peter in ~~k~~ his third epistle and first chapter, verse 23-25 with the
words, Being born again, not of corruptible seed but of incorruptible, by the
Word of God which lives and abides forever. For ~~a~~ all ~~k~~ flesh is as grass and
all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withereth. The flower
thereof falleth ~~awy-~~ away, but the Word of the Lord endures forever. And when
Peter wrote his second epistle, there in the very first chapter he expresses the
~~fat-~~ fact that ~~unless~~ what he was ~~giving-~~ giving was truth.
