This is brought out very clearly in the 19th Psalm ~~κ~~ where we begin, The ~~heavens~~ heavens declare the glory of God and ~~κ~~ the firmament showeth ~~κ~~ His handiwork. It doesn't say that the heavens ~~κ~~ tells us of God's goodness . It doesn't tell~~κ~~ us of His love. It doesn't tell us of His forgiveness. It ~~doen~~ doesn't tell us how we can make our lives worthwhile, but it does tell us of ~~His~~ the greatness of His existence, of His power, and of His majesty. The heavens declare the glory of God and the firmament showeth~~κ~~ His handiwork. Day unto day uttereth speech and night unto night showeth ~~knowledge~~. knowledge. There is no speech nor language where their language is not heard. And the Apostle Paul makes up this same thought ~~κ~~ over in the first chapter of ~~Ro-a~~ Romans where he tells us in that first chapter of Romans , in verses 18-20, For the wrath~~κ~~ of God is revealed from ~~κ~~ heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, holding the truth in unrighteousness, because that which may be known <sup>of</sup> ~~in~~ God is manifest in the; m, for God hath showed it unto them, that the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made , even His eternal power and Godhead, so th~~a~~ t they are without ~~κ-ε-κ~~ excuse. ~~Thus~~ Thus we see what ~~Paul~~ Paul says , that the ...man can see God's power, none of us can do anything without ~~revel-i-e~~ revealing something about ourselves . ...but this communication is very incomplete and so the 19th Psalm goes on to tell us~~κ~~ about the Law of the Lord, that God has ~~κ κ~~ revealed Himself through His ~~κ~~
